3. FRENCH SEAM AT SHOULDER			
(If not French seam award '0')			
- Seam made with straight stitchery (1)			
- Seam well trimmed i.i. no threads in the R.S. (1)			
- Seam well knife edged (1)			
- Evenness of seam width (½) correct size 0.4 – 0.5cm (½)			
- Seam well pressed (½) toward back (½)

4. OPEN SEAM AT SIDE SEAM			
(if not open seam award '0')			
- Seam joined with straight stitchery (1)			
- Well neatened raw edges (½ x 2 = (1)			
- Evenness of seam allowance (½ x 2 = (1)			
- Correct size of seam allowance i.e. 1cm to within 2mm ½ x 2 = (1)

5. <u>FACED SLIT OPENING</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Neatening the three raw edges of facing $\frac{1}{2}$ x3= ($\frac{1}{2}$) - Right side facing placed on RS of sleeve while attaching ($\frac{1}{2}$) - Correctly stitched at marked position (1) - Facing turned to WS of sleeve ($\frac{1}{2}$) - Knife edging along opening ($\frac{1}{2}$) - Facing edges concealed into binding ($\frac{1}{2}$) - Facing catch stitched into position ($\frac{1}{2}$)

6. <u>SLEEVE</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Underarm seam open ($\frac{1}{2}$) and neatened ($\frac{1}{2}$) - Binding correctly machined on RS (1) and hemmed on WS (1) of sleeve - Evenness of binding (1) - Ties correctly stitched when RS are facing (1) and well knife edged (1) - Gathers well positioned between dots (1) - Gathers evenly distributed (1) - Notches matched front ($\frac{1}{2}$) back ($\frac{1}{2}$) - Underarm seam matched with side seam (1), crown matched with shoulder seam (1) - Good hang of sleeve - Smooth stitchery round armhole left untrimmed ($\frac{1}{2}$) and unneatened ($\frac{1}{2}$)

7. <u>FACING</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - joining of facing at shoulder seam with open seam ($\frac{1}{2}$) seam trimmed ($\frac{1}{2}$) and left unneatened ($\frac{1}{2}$) free edge of facing edge stitches (1) - joining facing to garment at neckline along SL ($\frac{1}{2}$) - Neckline seam trimmed ($\frac{1}{2}$) and snipped / notched ($\frac{1}{2}$) - Knife edging along neckline ($\frac{1}{2}$) with facing pressed towards WS catch stitching at shoulder or under stitching ($\frac{1}{2}$) facing in position
