A pattern of a girl's blouse is provided. You are advised to study the sketches, instructions and layout carefully before you begin the test.

MATERIALS PROVIDED

- 1. Pattern Pieces
 - A. Blouse front
 - B. Blouse back
 - C. Sleeve
 - D. Back neck facing
 - E. Cuff
 - F. Sleeve opening facing.
- 2. Plain lightweight cotton fabric 65cm long by 90cm wide
- Sewing cotton thread to match the fabric.
- 4. A button-1cm in diameter
- 5. One large envelope.

NB: Cut the third piece using pattern E for a cuff interface.

THE TEST

Using the materials provided, cut out and make the RIGHT SIDE of a girl's blouse to show the following processes:-


- (a) Making of the under arm dart at the blouse front.
- (b) Making of a shoulder seam using a French seam.
- (c) Making of the side seam using an open seam (Neaten the seam).
- (d) Joining of the blouse front facing and the back neck facing using an open seam. (Do not neaten).
- (e) Neaten the edge of the facing.
- (f) Working of the faced slit sleeve opening.
- (g) Working of the under arm seam using an open seam (Do not neaten).
- (h) Attaching the sleeve to the armhole (Ease the crown) using the plain seam (Neaten half).
- (i) Preparation and attaching of the cuff.
- (j) Making a buttonhole and fixing a button.
- (k) Management of the blouse hem using machine hemming.


At the end of the examination, firmly sew onto your work, on a single fabric, a label bearing your **Name** and **Index number**.

Remove the needle and pins from your work, then fold your work carefully and place it in the envelope provided.

Do not put scraps of fabric in the envelope.
