3. The Optional Set Text

(a) **The Short Story:**

Emilia Ilieva, Waveney Olembo – <u>When the Sun Goes Down</u>

The war of the ears by Moses Isegawa "Civil wars, especially those lead by militia groups can have devasting effects on a country". With evidence drawn from the story 'The war of the ears' by Moses Isegawa, validate the above statement.

(b) **Drama: by Francis Imbuga**, <u>Betrayal in the City</u>.
