ALTERNATIVE A: DRAWING OR PAINTING.

Mechanical tools are not allowed in this options.

EITHER (DRAWING)

1. Imaginative or memory composition. Using a black biro or ink and pen or pencil, draw a compostion based on the phase

'A tax collector in a busy open air market'

OR (PAINTING)

2. Composite a picture from memory based on the phrase 'a captivating story besides the bonfire at night.'

ALTERNATIVE B: GRAPHIC DESIGN

Mechanical tools are allowed in this options.

EITHER

- **3.** Design a motif derived from organic (natural) source. The motif will be used for a repeated pattern on fabric which is to be used by a firm dealing with marine plants and animals.
 - a) Produce the motif in an area measuring 10cm²
 - b) Repeat the motif in (a) above in 8 units (grids) of 5 cm² to create a pattern on a separate space. (Rescale as is appropriate)

4. Design a poster measuring 50cm by 40cm with the message "HEALTHY ENVIRONMENT FOR HEALTHY MIND" The design should be composite and in 3 colours.
