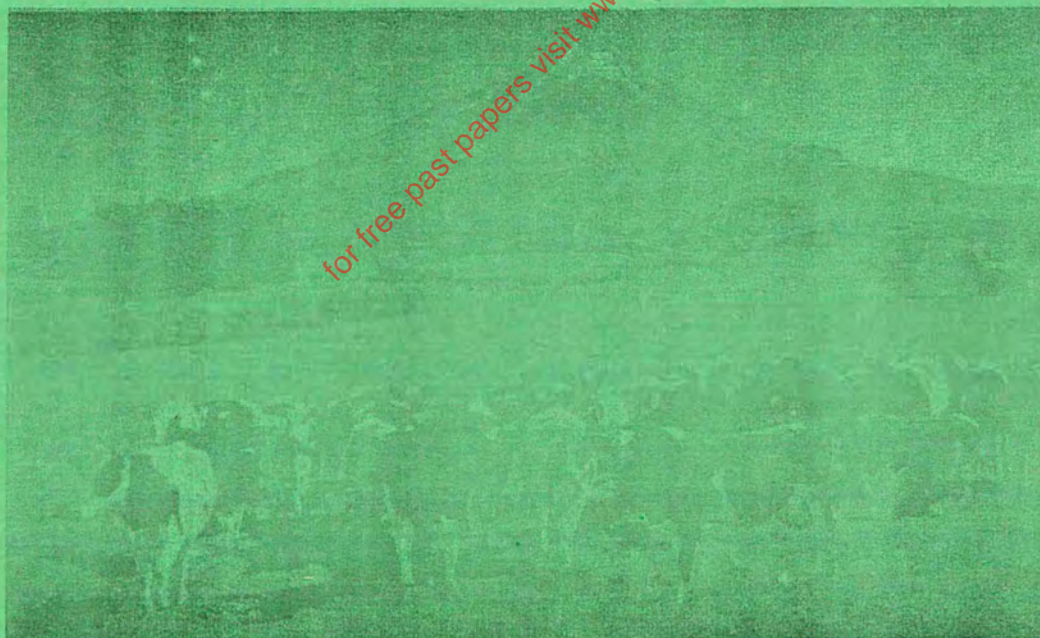

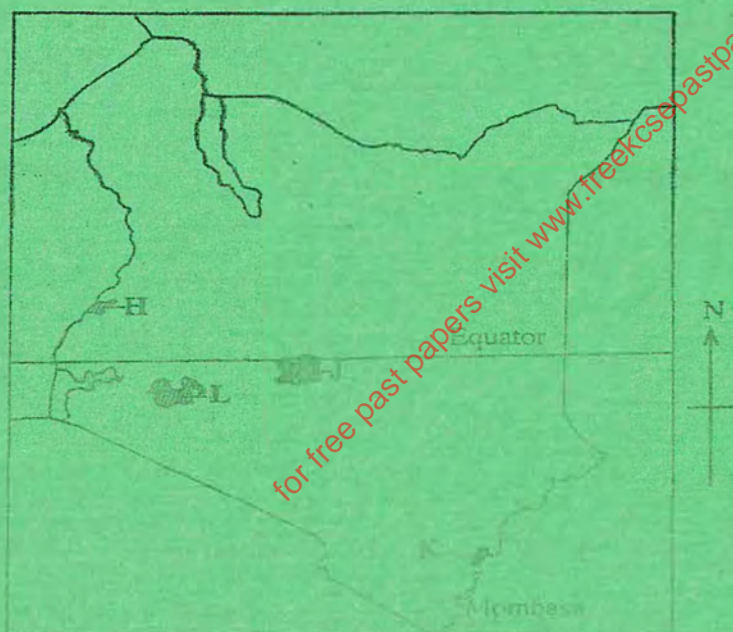
6. Study the photograph below and answer question (a).
