













1. UFAHAMU (Alama 15)

Soma Makala yafuatayo kisha ujibu maswali.

Yasemekana kuwa Shungwaya ndicho kitovu cha watu waishio Giriama katika janibu za pwani ya Kenya na wanaojulikana kwa jumla kana Wamijikenda. Yaaminika kuwa bado wakiwa Shugwaya, walimuua Mgalla mmoja mwenyeji wa Shungwaya na kitendo hicho kiliamsha hasira kali za Wagalla, hata ikawawia vigumu Wamijikenda kuishi kwa usalama pamoja na ndugu zao hao.

Hata hivyo, Wamijikenda hawakugura mara moja wala wote kwa pamoja bali walihama katika vipindi tofati na katika makundi madogomadogo. Kila kundi lilofika Giriama lilijenga ‘kaya’ au mji wake. Kwa jumla, walihama kwa makundi tisa.

Vile vile, Wamijikenda walihama na fingo yao ambayo ilifukiwa na viongozi wao katikati ya kaya zao, palipokuwa na msitu mdogo. Hakuna ajuaye hasa mahali ilipofukiwa ila wazee hao walipenda kufanya baraza mahali hapo.

Mnamo mwaka wa 1870, mzee Menza na mkewe walibarikiwa kufungua kizazi kwa kupata mtoto wa kike waliyemwita Mekatilili. Walimlea vizuri na alipoanza kuzungumza, alionyesha dalili za kuwa na kipawa cha pekee. Kwanza, alipenda kujua kila kitu kilichoishus jamii yake na pili alichukizwa sana na kiumbe aliyemdhulumu kiumbe mwenzake. Kwa mfano, aliwaonea vipepeo imani walipoliwa na ndege. Tena alizipenda sana miла na desturi za watu wa jamii yake – Wamijikenda.

Siku moja, baada ya Mekatilili kufikia utu uzima, mama yake alimwita chemba akamwambia, “Mwanangu sasa umeshabalehe, nami ningependa kuwaona wajukuu wangu kabla sijawafuata wazee waliotangulia. Waonaje tukkuoza? Mimi na baba yako tumepata mume ambaye ni kufu yako kabisa.”

“Ninaelewa, maana hizi ni desturi zetu, lakini ningefurahi zaidi kama mnjeniruhusu nijichagulie mume ninayempenda.” Binti alimjibu mamaye.

“Mnazi na uwe mrefu, huyumba kufuata upemo.” Mama akajibu. Tangu hapo binti akawa hana la kujibu ila kukubali.

Siku ya harusi, watu wengi walihudhuria na wakastarehe kwa tembo la mnazi ambalo lilikuwa limetengenezewa kwa wingi. Jioni hiyo, mekatilili alichukuliwa kwa mumewe Masendeni, karibu na mto Sabaki. Ikawa hangeonana na wazazi wake kila siku kama ingalivyokuwa mapenzi yake. Wakati huu kote nchini Kenya kulikuwa kumejaa wageni, wengi wao wakiwa walowezi na watawala wa kibeberu. Walikuwa wameanzisha mashamba ya mikonge, kahawa na chai.

Walihitaji watu wa kupalilia mashamba yao hayo. Hata hivyo Waafrika hawakuwa na haja ya kulima wala pesa. Hata walipolima, ni kwa minajili ya kubadilishana mazao na kula. Iliwabidi Wazungu kutumia mizungu ili kuwashurutisha Waafrka kuwalimia. Baadhi ya mikakati waliyobuni ni kuwateka nyara watu barobaro na kutoza kodi. Ni katika harakati kama hizo.

ambapo mumewe Mekatilili alitekwa, asirudi tena kwake. Wakati uo huo, wazazi wa Mekatilili waliaga dunia.

Mambo haya yalimpa mekatilili msukumo. Baada ya muda wa kuomboleza kuisha, alijiunga na wazee wapigania ukombozi, mmoja wao akiwa Wanje, kakaye mumewe. Aliwaunganisha wanawake na kuwahimiza wasiige mila na desturi za kizungu. Aliwahutubia wanaume na kuwakumbusha kuwa ilikuwa lazima wailinde nchi yao. Siku moja alishikwa kwa kuwalisha watu kiapo. Alipelekwa bara, Kisii, mbali kabisa na kwao, Masharibi mwa Kenya na akatiwa kizuizini pamoja na Wanje. Hata hivyo, walifaulu kutoroka na kwa muda wa siku ayami walipitia kwenye mabonde na milima, misitu na nyika hadi wakarudi Giriama.

Mabeberu walikasirika sana. Hata hivyo, walikuwa wamechelewa. Katika safari yao kurudi Giriama, walifaulu kuhubiria wengi dhidi ya mgeni. Vita vya ukombozi vilikuwa vimeshika.

Happiness arises largely from the mental qualities of contentment, confidence, serenity and active good-will. It includes the pain of losing as well as the pleasure of finding. It thrives best in a crowded life. The men and women who are recorded in history and biography as the most happy were with always somewhat more to do than they could possibly do. Every waking hour of their lives was occupied with ambitious projects, literature, love, politics, science, friendship, commerce, professions, trades, their religious faith, and a thousand other matters. The secret of happiness may be found by making each of these interests count to its utmost as part of the fabric of life.

We need to avoid the extremes of sluggish placidity and feverish activity. We are not going to be satisfied with **felicity** which resembles that of a stone, unfeeling and unmoving, but will look back from future years with sorrow and regret if we run to and fro, giving in to what Socrates called 'the itch'.

Happiness obviously includes two sorts of behavior: active and passive. We may say that the active part consists in searching and sharing, while the passive part is made up of security and possession. Neither part is complete in itself, nor yields full satisfaction if it is over-emphasized. Philosophers from the ancient Greeks to the present day have been extolling a balanced life as the happiest life, and many unhappy people can, when they face the issue, trace their discontent to imbalance.

The recipe for happiness cannot be given in any single word because its many virtues have to be combined in their proper quantities, at the proper times for proper purposes.

It is legitimate to seek happiness. We cannot help observing that while followers of some schools of thought are telling us to avoid seeking happiness, they intimate that if we do so, we shall be happy.

The search requires a plan. We need to know what sort of happiness we seek, what the ingredients are, what our strongest wants are, and what we have to start with. We should train ourselves to keep the programme simple, and free from complications and side trips, to pay attention to little things, to deflate quickly after being praised and to bounce back quickly from disappointment, to seize to create opportunities to put our special abilities to work, to seek excellence in everything we do, to remain modest, and to review and revise periodically.

Most of us do not really have to seek far and wide. Happiness grows at our own fireside, if we cultivate it.



TYPES OF OPERATING SYSTEMS



When identifying an operating system, it is important to consider certain aspects of classification in order to group them correctly. Therefore operating systems can be classified according to:

1. Number of tasks
2. Number of users
3. User interface

CLASSIFICATION ACCORDING TO NUMBER OF TASKS

SINGLE TASKING OPERATING SYSTEM	MULTITASKING OPERATING SYSTEM
allows the computer to perform only one task at a time	allows a single CPU to perform several operations at the same time.
the processing task taking place must first finish executing before another task is assigned the processor	the processor switches from one task to another as directed by the operating system at a very high rate

CLASSIFICATION ACCORDING TO INTERFACE

INTERFACE refers to the method of interaction between the user and the computer and interface is seen as what lies between the user and the computer that brings them together in an understandable form by the user, hence making the use of the computer possible.

The underlying principle in operating system design is to make the interface as easy as possible. The consideration of operating systems mainly depends on the interface, that is user friendly (ease of using) it is, therefore the more user friendly the interface is, the more easy to operate the computer.

COMMAND-LINE BASED OPERATING SYSTEMS

Command-line user interface operating systems was used by the first operating systems which only provided the user with a black screen to type a command at the prompt. The computer reads the typed command from the command line and executes it. For the command -line operating system to be more user friendly, English like words- descriptive verbs ie print, copy etc and unique abbreviations ie DEL, REN, CHKDSK etc were used as commands.

Command-line operating systems are not user friendly because;

- It is difficult to remember all the commands
- It cannot process complex graphics
- It cannot support the emerging hardware and software technologies.
